

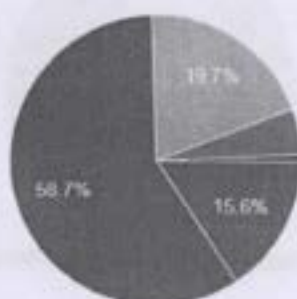







## Graphical analysis of Students' feedback response



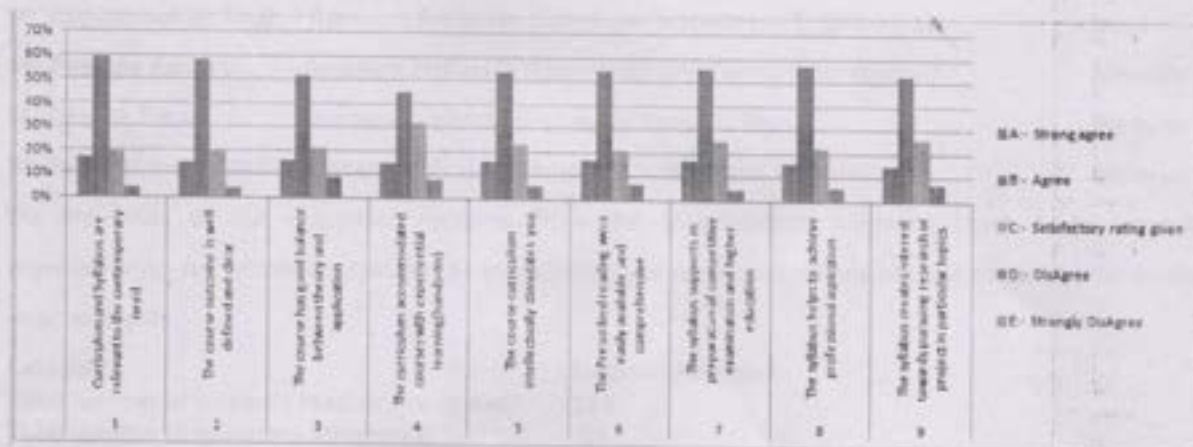

## Graphical analysis of Students' feedback response



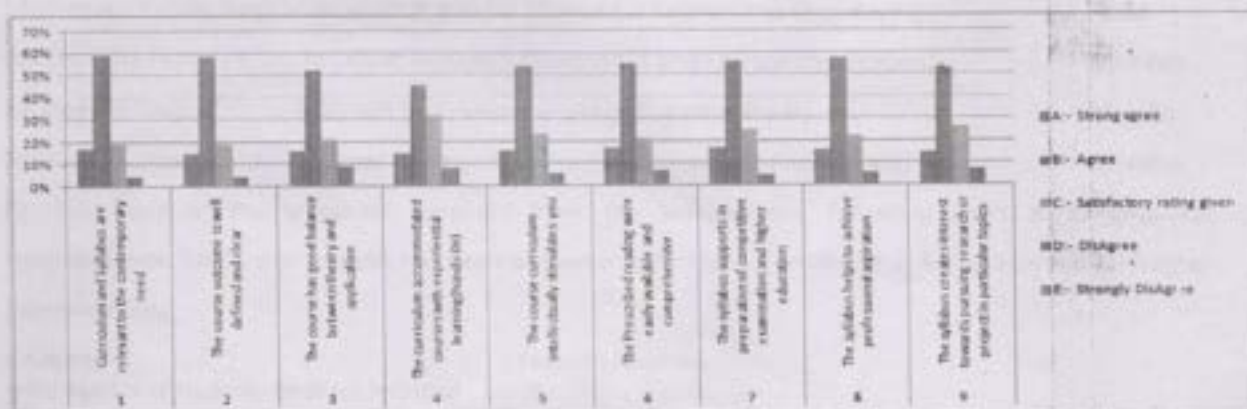







### Graphical analysis of Alumni's' feedback response



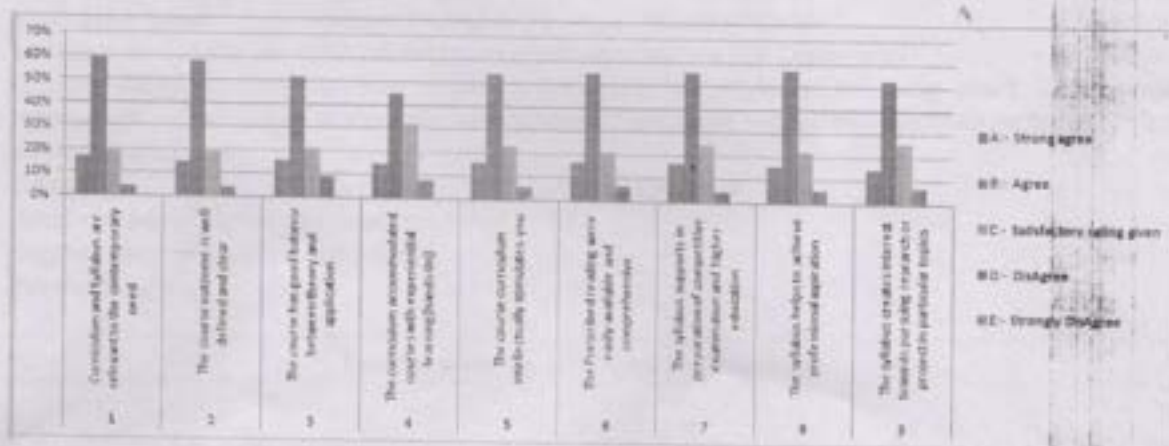






## Graphical analysis of employer' feedback response






